The days are observed from sunset to sunset. They will begin at the evening of the prior day, and continue until the evening of the listed day.

EVERY SEVENTH DAY (SATURDAY) IS THE SABBATH DAY AND MUST BE OBSERVED. NO WORK IS ALLOWED TO BE DONE ON THESE HOLY DAYS.

PESACH	April 3
FEAST OF UNLEVENED BREAD	April 4
SEVENTH DAY FEAST	April 10
SHAVUOT - FEAST OF HARVEST	May 31
YOM TERUAH (DAY OF NOISE)	September 13
YOM KIPPUR (DAY OF ATONEMENT)	September 22
SUCCOTH (FEAST OF TABERNACLES)	September 27
SHEMINI ATZERET (EIGHT DAY SOLEMN ASSEMBLY)	October 4
